“Edmonton’s Economic Outlook”

Thanks to massive oil sands and other energy related investments in northern Alberta over the past few years, the Edmonton economy has experienced tremendous growth, leading most Canadian cities in terms of job creation and new home construction activity. With over \$140 billion in proposed projects in Alberta over the next 5 to 10 years, it’s hard to imagine that the Edmonton economy is going to slow down any time soon.

However, despite this strong economic environment, there are a few issues on the near term horizon that may pose as challenges to our economy.

PRESENTER:

Paul Tsounis is the Chief Corporate Economist for the City of Edmonton, and President of the Economics Society of Northern Alberta. In his current role with the City of Edmonton, Paul is responsible for conducting economic forecasts and long term demographic projections for the city of Edmonton and the Edmonton region. Prior to his present position, he served as Senior Economist for Alberta Finance, where he conducted economic and financial forecasts for the Alberta economy, and assisted in the preparation of several provincial budgets and quarterly forecasts. Paul was also an economist for the Oil Sands Business Unit at Alberta Energy, where he conducted various economic projections and performed financial analysis of oil sands related projects in Alberta. Paul holds a Master’s Degree in Economics and Finance from the University of Alberta, and a Bachelors degree in economics from the University of Calgary.
